 - C. The young men are strong overcomers, because of the Word of God (14e-h)
 - 1. Young men, I wrote to you (14e)
 - 2. You are strong overcomers, because of the Word of God (14f-h)
 - a That you are strong (14f)
 - b And the Word of God is remaining in you (14g)
 - c And you have overcome the evil [one] (14h)
