### v. 11

παρακαλῶ                      PAI1sg                      fr. παρακαλω  
to urge strongly, appeal to, urge, exhort, encourage  
to ask for something earnestly and with propriety, to ask for (earnestly), to request, to plead for, to appeal to, earnest request, appeal

παροίκους  
stranger, alien, one who lives in a place not his home. fig. of the Christians whose real home is in heaven person who lives for a time where is not his normal residence

παρεπιδήμους  
stranger, exile, sojourner – of the Christians who are not at home in this world

ἀπέχεσθαι                      PMInf                      fr. ἀπεχω  
Cf. Acts 15:20, 29  
keep away, abstain w/gen. of thing  
to keep on avoiding doing something to restrain from, to avoid doing.

σαρκικῶν  
fleshly, carnal, belonging to the realm of the flesh in so far as it is weak, sinful, and transitory, and in these respects is the opposite of the spirit.  
typical of human nature with a special focus on the more base, worldly, physical desires

ἐπιθυμιῶν  
desires, strong desires, lusts, longing

στρατεύονται                      PMI3pl                      fr. στρατευομαι  
do military service, of the struggles of the passions within the human soul.  
to engage in war or battle as a soldier.

ἀναστροφὴν  
conduct, behavior, way of life

καλήν  
morally good, praiseworthy, noble

καταλαλοῦσιν                      PAI3pl                      fr. καταλαλω  
speak against, speak evil of, defame, slander

κακοποιῶν

evildoer, criminal

one who customarily engages in doing what is bad

ἐποπτεύοντες

PAptcpMPN

fr. ἐποπτεύω

Observe something, see, with continuity and intent, to watch

δοξάσωσιν

AAS3pl

fr. δοξάζω

praise, honor, magnify

ἐπισκοπῆς

visitation – either good “the gracious visitation can manifest itself as protection, care “ cf. Lk. 19:44 or bad sense, as punishment, coming of divine power, either for benefit or judgment.
