like minded, united in Spirit, harmonious  
being of the same mind, having the same thoughts

συμπαθεῖς

sympathetic, understanding

φιλάδελφοι

having affection for an associate, having brotherly love, having mutual affection, love or affection for fellow believers

εὐσπλαγχνοὶ

having tender feelings for someone, tenderhearted, compassionate, affectionate

ταπεινόφρονες

humble, being humble, having humility

### v. 9

ἀποδιδόντες

PAptcpMPN

fr. ἀποδιδωμι

give away, give out, give back, return, recompense, reward, to recompense someone  
whether pos. or neg. depending on what that individual deserves

κακὸν

socially or morally reprehensible, bad, evil, harmful and damaging

ἀντὶ

a marker of an exchange relation, for, in place of, replaced by another, instead of,

λοιδορίαν

verbal abuse, reproach, reviling, to speak in insulting manner, to slander, insult.

τοῦναντίον

on the other hand, marker of alternative serving as emphatic contrast, contrary, rather

εὐλογοῦντες

PAptcpMPN

fr. εὐλογεω

to bless= to call down God's gracious power to ask God's divine favor

εἰς

marker of goals, into, to, marker of intent, often with the implication of expected result,  
for the purpose of, in order to

ἐκλήθητε                      API2pl                      fr. καλεω  
choose for receipt of a special benefit or experience, call, cf. 1:15, 5:10  
to invite someone to accept responsibilities for a particular task, implying a new  
relationship to the one who does the calling

εὐλογίαν  
blessing as a benefit bestowed by God

κληρονομήσητε              AAS2pl                      fr. κληρονομεω  
to acquire, obtain, come into possession of something – cf. Heb 12:17  
to receive something of considerable value which has not been earned

ἀγαπᾶν                      PAInf                      fr. ἀγαπαω  
to have high esteem for or satisfaction with something, take pleasure in something, to like  
or love something on the basis of a high regard for its value or importance

ιδεῖν                      AAInf                      fr. εἶδον  
to experience something, see, to experience an event or state, cf. Jn 3:36, 8:51

ἀγαθὰς  
pertaining with a relatively high standard of quality, useful, beneficial, happy  
having the proper characteristics or performing the expected function in a fully  
satisfactory way, good, nice, pleasant

παυσάτω                      AAImp3sg                      fr. παυω  
stop, cause to stop, quiet, hinder, keep something from something, to cause to cease, to  
make stop

δόλον  
taking advantage through craft and underhanded methods, deceit, cunning, treachery,  
cf. 2:1, 22, to deceive by using trickery and falsehood

ἐκκλινάτω                      AAImp3sg                      fr. ἐκκλινω  
turn away from, shun, avoid  
cease doing something with implication of doing alternative

ποιησάτω                      AAImp3sg                      fr. ποιεω  
do, cause, bring about, accomplish

ζητησάτω                      AAImp3sg                      fr. ζητεω  
try to obtain, desire to possess something

εἰρήνην

state of harmony, peace, concord, in personal relationships,  
cf. 2 Tim 2:22, Gal 5:22, Heb 12:13, Rom 14:19

διωξάτω

AAImp3sg

fr. διωκω

pursue, strive for, seek after, aspire to something, to do something with intense effort &  
definite purpose or goal

extension toward goal or place, into, in, toward, to

δέησιν

entreaty exclusively addressed to God, request, plea  
that which is asked with urgency based on presumed need, request, plea, prayer
