pertaining to being worthy of belief or trust, trustworthy, faithful, dependable, inspiring trust/faith
pertaining to being trusted, faithful, dependable, reliable, trustworthy

λογίζομαι

PM/PdepI1sg

fr. λογίζομαι

to hold a view about something, think, believe, be of the opinion
to hold a view or have an opinion with regard to something, to consider

ὀλίγων

being relatively small in number, few, cf. 1:6, 3:20, 5:10
being relatively small on a scale of extent, little, small, short, used adverbially, in a short time, quickly
pertaining to a relatively brief extent of time, a little while, for a little while, a short time, brief, briefly

παρακαλῶν

PAPtcpMPN

fr. παρακαλεω

to urge strongly, appeal to, urge, exhort, encourage, cf. 2:11, 5:1
to cause someone to be encouraged or consoled, either by verbal or non-verbal means, to encourage, to console, encouragement

ἐπιμαρτυρῶν

PAPtcpMPN

fr. επιμαρτυρεω

to affirm that something is true, bear witness, attest
to provide information about a person or an event concerning which the speaker has direct knowledge, to witness

ἀληθῆ

pertaining to being true, real, genuine, not imaginary

χάριν

beneficent disposition toward someone, favor, grace, gracious care/help, goodwill, practical application of goodwill, favor, gracious deed/gift, benefaction, cf. 1:10, 13, 3:7, 5:5, 10
favorable attitude toward someone or something

στητε.

AAImp2pl

fr. ἵστημι

stand, stand firm so as to remain stable, stand firm, hold one's ground, stand fast
to continue firmly or well established in a particular state, to firmly remain, to continue steadfastly

Ἀσπάζεταιται

PM/PdepI3sg

fr. ασπάζομαι

to engage in hospitable recognition of another, greet, welcome
to employ certain set phrases as a part of the process of greeting, whether communicated directly or indirectly, to greet, to send greetings

συνεκλεκτή

pertaining to being chosen together with, also chosen, chosen the same as you

pertaining to being selected together with, one who is also chosen, what is chosen together with

ἀσπάσασθε

AMdepImp2pl

fr. ασπαζομαι

see above

φιλήματι

a kiss, manner of formal greeting

kiss, either as an expression of greeting or as a sign of special affection and appreciation

ἀγάπης

the quality of warm regard for and interest in another, esteem, affection, regard, love, usually not referring to sexual attraction

to have love for someone or something, based on sincere appreciation and high regard, to love, to regard with affection

εἰρήνη

state of well being, peace, corresponding to Hebrew Shalom, welfare, health, cf. 1:2

set of favorable circumstances involving peace and tranquility, peace, tranquility, freedom from anxiety and inner turmoil
