ἀπόστολος

messenger with extraordinary status, God's messenger, envoy, a group of highly honored believers with a special function as God's envoys, one who proclaimed the gospel

One who fulfills the role of being a special messenger, the immediate followers of Jesus, Christians active in proclaiming the message of the Gospel, apostle, special messenger

κατ'

marker of norm of similarity or homogeneity, according to, in accordance with, in conformity with, according to, often the norm is at the same time the reason, so that in accordance with and because of are merged

marker of a relation involving similarity of process, in accordance with, in relation to

ἐπιταγήν

authoritative directive, command, order, injunction, 'in accordance with the command = by command'

that which has been specifically ordered or commanded, order, command, decree, ordinance, instruction

σωτήρος

one who rescues, savior, deliverer, preserver

one who saves, Savior

ἐλπίδος

that which is the basis for hoping, (foundation of) hope, of Christ, our hope

that which constitutes the cause or reason for hoping, the basis for hope, the reason for hope

V. 2

γνησίῳ

one who is considered a valid member of a family, legitimate, true, of affective relationship, especially as developed through sharing of values or experiences, 'true child in the faith' pertaining to possessing purported good character or quality, genuine, real

τέκνῳ

one who is dear to another, but without genetic relationship and without distinction in age, child, of a spiritual child in relation to master, apostle, or teacher

a person of any age for whom there is a special relationship of endearment and association, my child, my dear friend, my dear man, my dear one, my dear lad

πίστει

pertaining to being trusting, trusting, cherishing faith/trust, one who confesses the Christian faith, believing or a believer in the Lord
pertaining to trusting, one who trusts

χάρις

a beneficent disposition toward someone, favor, grace, gracious care, goodwill, divine favor in fixed formulas at the beginning of letters, grace
favorable attitude toward someone or something, favor, goodwill

ἔλεος

kindness or concern expressed for someone in need, mercy, compassion, pity, clemency, in greetings, cf. 2 Tim. 1:2
to show kindness or concern for someone in serious need, to show mercy, to be merciful toward, to have mercy on, mercy

εἰρήνη

state of well-being, peace, welfare and health, in greetings, 'grace and peace'
set of favorable circumstances involving peace and tranquility, peace, tranquility, a state of freedom from anxiety and inner turmoil, peace, freedom from worry

πατὴρ

the supreme deity, who is responsible for the origin and care of all that exists, Father, Parent
One who combines aspects of supernatural authority and care for his people, Father
