

## 2 Cor. 5:16-6:2

16. The result is that from now on, we know no one according to flesh (Although we have known Christ according to flesh, but now we are no longer knowing [Him in this way]). 17. The result is that if someone is in Christ, He or she is a new creation – the old things have come to an end. Behold, new things have come to be.

18. All these things are from God, the One Who reconciled us to Himself through Christ, and the One giving to us the ministry of reconciliation. 19. As that God was, in Christ, reconciling the world to Himself, not reckoning their transgressions against them, and assigning to us the message of reconciliation. 20. Therefore, we work as ambassadors on behalf of Christ, as God is making His appeal through us. We are pleading on behalf of Christ: Be reconciled to God.

21. God made the One Who did not know sin, to be sin on our behalf, in order that we may become the righteousness of God in Him.

1. [We are] working together, and we are encouraging you not to receive the grace of God to no effect. 2. For He says:

At the favorable time, I listened to you

And I helped you in the day of salvation.

Behold, now is the favorable time. Behold, now is the day of salvation.
