duration of time as episodic, of a frequently recurring action or situation, continually, constantly, 'from time to time'
duration of time, either continuous or episodic, but without limits, always, constantly, continually

ὑπομιμήσκειν PAInf fr. ὑπομιμνσκω
to put another in mind of something, remind someone of something
to cause to recall and to think about again, to remind, to cause to remember, to cause to think about again

καίπερ
although
marker of concession, although, though, even though, 'I will always remind you of these matters, even though you already know them'

εἰδότας PfAPtcpMPA fr. οἶδα
to have information about, know
to possess information about, to know, to know about, to have knowledge of, to be acquainted with, acquaintance

ἐστηριγμένους PfPPtcpMPA fr. στηρίζω
to cause to be inwardly firm or committed, confirm, establish, strengthen
to cause someone to become stronger in the sense of more firm and unchanging in attitude or belief, to strengthen, to make more firm

παρούση PAPtcpFSD fr. παρειμι
to be available for use, at one's disposal, cf. v. 9
to be present at a particular time and place, to be present, to be here, to be there, to be at hand

ἀληθεία
the content of what is true, truth, especially of the content of Christianity as the ultimate truth
the content of that which is true and thus in accordance with what actually happened, truth

that which is obligatory in view of certain requirements of justice, right, fair, equitable, ‘I consider it right’
pertaining to being proper or right in the sense of being fully justified, proper, right

ἡγοῦμαι

PM/PdepIIsg

fr. ἡγεομαι

to engage in an intellectual process, think, consider, regard, ‘I consider it my duty’
to hold a view or have an opinion with regard to something, to hold a view, to have an opinion,
to consider, to regard

ἐφ’

marker of temporal associations, in the time of, at, on, for, answering the question ‘how long?’
for, over a period of, ‘to the degree that, in so far as’
marker of the extent of time within a unit, during, in the course of, within, for

σκηνώματι

habitation, of the body, ‘=remain alive’
figurative extension of ‘tent’, temporary habitation in the human body, body, ‘I shall soon put off
this body of mine’

διεγείρειν

PAInf

fr. διεγειρω

wake up, arouse, figurative, arouse, stir up
marker of a causative relation, with the implication of a significant change in state, to cause, ‘to
cause you to remember’

ὑπομνήσει

the act of calling to someone’s mind, reminding, ‘by a reminder, i.e. as I remind you’
to cause to recall and to think about again, to remind, to cause to remember, to cause to think
about again, ‘to stir you up by reminding you’

ταχινή

pertaining to taking place without delay, coming soon, imminent, swift, cf. 2:1
pertaining to a point of time subsequent to another point of time, with emphasis upon the
relatively brief interval between the two points of time, soon, very soon

ἀπόθεσις

removal, getting rid of, ‘removal of my tent euphemism for death’
to put or take something away from its normal location, to put away, to put out of the way, to
remove

σκηνώματός

of comparison, just as
marker of similarity in events and states, with the possible implication of something being in accordance with something else, just as, in comparison to

ἐδήλωσέν AAI3sg fr. δηλωω
to make something clear to the understanding, explain, clarify
to make something known by making evident what was either unknown before or what may have been difficult to understand, to make known, to make plain, to reveal

σπουδάσω FAI1sg fr. σπουδαζω
to be especially conscientious in discharging an obligation, be zealous/eager, take pains, make every effort, be conscientious
to do something with intense effort and motivation, to work hard, to do one's best, to endeavor

ἐκάστοτε
at any time, always
duration of time, with reference to a series of occasions, always, at all times, on every occasion, 'I will do my best to provide a way for you to remember these matters at all times after my death'

μετὰ
marker of time after another point of time, after
marker of a point of time closely associated with a prior point of time, after

ἔξοδον
departure from among the living, euphemism for death, 'after my death' cf. Lk. 9:31
figurative from 'departure', to depart from life, as a euphemistic expression for death, to leave this life, to die, death, departure, 'after my death'

μνήμην
a recollection that one has of events, opposite of ignoring by forgetting, recollection, memory, 'recall something to mind'
to recall information from memory, but without necessarily the implication that persons have actually forgotten, to remember, to recall, to think about again, memory, remembrance, 'I will do my best, then, to provide a way for you to remember these matters at all times after my death'
