V. 1

ἤδη

a point of time prior to another point of time, with implication of completion, now, already, by this time

a point of time preceding another point of time and implying completion, already

ἀγαπητοί

pertaining to one who is dearly loved, dear, beloved, prized, valued

pertaining to one who or that which is loved, object of one's affection, one who is loved, beloved, dear

δευτέραν

next to the first in a sequence or series, second in a series

second in a series involving either time, space, or set, second, in the second place, secondly

ἐπιστολήν

letter, epistle

an object containing writing addressed to one or more persons, letter

διεγείρω

PAIsg

fr. διεγειρω

wake up, arouse someone who is asleep, figurative – arouse, stir up

marker of a causative relation, with the implication of a significant change in state, to cause, 'to cause you to remember'

ὑπομνήσει

the act of calling to someone's mind, reminding, by a reminder, i.e. as I remind you

to cause to recall and to think about again, to remind, to cause to remember, to cause to think about again, cf. v. 13

εἰλικρινῆ

in a moral sense, pertaining to being sincere, without hidden motives, or pretense, pure, 'pure mind'

pertaining to being sincere in the sense of having pure motivation, sincere, without hidden motives

διάνοιαν

mind as a mode of thinking, disposition, thought, mind

the psychological faculty of understanding, reasoning, thinking, and deciding, mind

V. 2

μνησθῆναι APInf fr. μιμνησκω
to recall information from memory, remember, recollect, remind oneself
to recall information from memory, but without necessarily the implication that persons have actually forgotten, to remember, to recall, to think about again, memory, remembrance, (I want you) to remember the words that were spoken long ago by the holy prophets'

προειρημένων PfPPtcpNPG fr. προειπω
to tell beforehand, foretell, tell/proclaim beforehand, warn, of prophetic utterances concerning future events and circumstances, of a scripture passage
to say in advance what is going to happen, to tell ahead of time, to predict

ῥημάτων
that which is said, word, saying, expression, or statement of any kind
that which has been stated or said, with primary focus upon the content of the communication, word, saying, message, statement, question

ἁγίων
pertaining to being dedicated or consecrated to the service of God, in the cultic sense, dedicated to God, holy, sacred, i.e. reserved for God and God's service, of human beings, consecrated to God, holy, pure, reverent
pertaining to being dedicated or consecrated to the service of God, devout, godly, dedicated

προφητῶν
a person inspired to proclaim or reveal divine will or purpose, prophet, of prophetic personalities in the OT who bear a message from God
one who proclaims inspired utterances on behalf of God, prophet, inspired preacher

ἀποστόλων
of messengers with extraordinary status, especially of God's messenger, envoy, of a group of highly honored believers with a special function as God's envoys, cf. 1:1
one who fulfills the role of being a special messenger, apostle, special messenger

ἐντολῆς
a mandate or ordinance, command, of commands given by divine authorities, of God's expectation of Christians, with special reference to their ethical decisions, 'the command of the Lord and Savior (given) through your apostles'
that which is authoritatively commanded, commandment, order

σωτήρος
one who rescues, savior, deliverer, preserver
one who saves, Savior
