



1&2 Chronicles – 29 & 36 chapters

Title:

English- Chronicles i.e. historical records, official accounts

Hebrew- “events/happenings of the days”

Greek- “things omitted” [from Samuel/Kings]

Author:

Anonymous, tradition suggests possibly Ezra

Occasion and Purpose:

Probably written as the Hebrews were recently returned from the Babylonian exile. Times were difficult and it was not easily apparent that they were living in God’s blessing and promises. Probably written to encourage the returned exiles that God had not forgotten them, to remind them that God’s promises were still in effect, to challenge them with the fact that God brings revival in times of national repentance.

Themes:

1. David and his dynasty
2. The Temple and the worship of God

Summary:

1 Chronicles- The history of Israel from a different perspective. It keys mostly on the religious life of Israel, especially the ministry in the temple. Highlights are the temple planning and David's military victories.

2 Chronicles- Continuation of 1 Chronicles. Highlights are the reforms under Hezekiah and Josiah and the eventual destruction of Jerusalem and captivity in Babylon.
