take off, lit. of clothes, fig. lay aside, rid self of, cease to do what one is accustomed to  
doing “stop living the way you did formerly”, cf. 4:22

ψεῦδος  
lie, falsehood, opposite of ἀληθεια

μέλη  
member, part, limb, fig. of the many sided organism of the Christian community,  
stressing unity, relationship, interdependence

ὀργίζεσθε                      PPImp2pl fr.                      οργίζομαι  
be angry

ἐπιδυέτω                      PAImp3sg fr.                      επιδυω  
sink down, set (of the sun)

παροργισμῶ  
angry mood, anger

v. 27

τόπον  
place, position, possibility, opportunity, chance, “do not give the devil a chance to exert  
his influence”, possibility of some occasion or opportunity

v. 28

κλέπτω                      PAPtcpMSN fr.                      κλεπτο  
steal, take secretly and without permission the property of someone else, theft

κοπιάτω                      PAImp3sg fr.                      κοπιαω  
work hard, toil, strive, struggle

μεταδιδόναι                      PAInf fr.                      μεταδιδωμι  
give a part of, impart, share with someone else what one has

σαπρὸς  
decayed, rotten, fig. bad, evil, unwholesome, evil word, speech, harmful, unwholesome,  
corrupting, contrast with ἀγαθος, cf. Matt. 7:18

ἐκπορευέσθω                      PMdepImp3sg fr.                      εκπορευομαι  
go out, fig. go out, proceed, of words and thoughts

οἰκοδομῆν  
building, construction, fig. of spiritual strengthening, edifying, building up, make more able

χρείας  
need, necessity, lack something, the thing that is lacking “such as will build up where it is necessary”

λυπεῖτε                                      PAImp2pl fr.                                      λυπεω  
grieve, pain, cause someone pain, make sad

ἐσφραγίσθητε                      API2pl fr.                                      σφραγιζω  
seal, mark with a seal for identification & mark ownership

ἀπολυτρόσεως  
release, from a captive condition, release, redemption, deliverance, the release from sin and finiteness that comes through Christ, redemption, acquittal, also the state of being redeemed

v. 31

πικρία  
bitterness, animosity, anger, harshness, bitter, intense resentment or hate, spite

θυμὸς  
passion, anger, intense anger & passionate outbursts, fury, rage

ὀργή  
anger, indignation, wrath

κραυγή  
lit. shouting clamor of exited persons, shouting in argument, shout, scream, cry

βλασφημία  
slander, defamation, blasphemy, abusive speech

ἀρθήτω                                      APImp3sg fr.                                      αιρω  
take away, remove, passive “let these things be taken...” cause someone to no longer experience something

χρηστοί

useful, suitable, worthy, good, kind, loving, benevolent

εὐσπλαγχνοι

tender hearted, compassionate, “instead, be kind and compassionate to one another”

χαριζόμενοι

PMdepPtcpMPN fr. χαριζομαι

give freely, remit, pardon, forgive, give generously, have gracious attitude in forgiveness

ἐχαρίσατο

AMdepI3sg fr.
