

Eph. 5:7-14 mws

v. 7

συμμέτοχοι

having a share with another in some possession or relationship, sharing with one who shares in a possession or a relationship, sharer, partner, cf. 3:6

v. 8

σκότος

the state of spiritual or moral darkness, bearer/victim/instrument of darkness
the realm of sin and evil, evil world, realm of evil, darkness

φῶς

light, that illuminates the spirit and soul of humans, is generally the element in which the redeemed person lives, rich in blessings without and within

τέκνα

a class of persons with a specific characteristic, children of, cf. 2:3
idiom, sons of light, persons to whom the truth of God has been revealed and who are presumably living according to such truth, children of the light, people of God

περιπατεῖτε

PAImp2pl

fr. περιπατεω

to conduct one's life, comport oneself, behave, live as habit of conduct, cf. 3:18, 4:17
to live or behave in a customary manner, with possible focus upon continuity of action, to live, to behave, to go about doing

v. 9

ἀγαθωσύνη

positive moral quality characterized especially by interest in the welfare of others, goodness
positive moral qualities of the most general nature, good, goodness, good act

δικαιοσύνη

the quality or characteristic of upright behavior, uprightness, righteousness, of uprightness in general
the act of doing what God requires, doing what is right

ἀληθεία

the quality of being in accord with what is true, truthfulness, dependability, uprightness in thought and deed
the content of that which is true and thus in accordance with what actually happened, truth

v. 10

δοκιμάζοντες PAPtcpMPN fr. δοκιμάζω

to make a critical examination of something to determine genuineness, put to the test, examine,
 try to learn what is pleasing to the Lord
 to try to learn the genuineness of something by examination and testing, often through actual use,
 to test, to examine, to try to determine the genuineness of, testing

εὐάρεστον

pleasing, acceptable, with reference to God, to whom something is acceptable
 pertaining to that which causes someone to be pleased, pleasing to, pleasingly

v. 11

συγκοινωνεῖτε PAImp2pl fr. συγκοινωνεω

to be associated with someone in some activity, be connected with something in the sense of
 actually taking part
 to be associated in some joint activity, with the implication, in some contexts, of a somewhat
 enduring relation, to participate with, to be in partnership with, to associate with

ἀκάρποις

unfruitful, fig. pertaining to being useless, unproductive
 pertaining to being useless, in the sense of being unproductive, useless

σκότους

see above

ἐλέγγετε PAImp2pl fr. ἐλέγχω

to scrutinize or examine carefully, bring to light, expose, set forth, cf. v. 13
 to state that someone has done wrong, with the implication that there is adequate proof of such
 wrongdoing, to rebuke, to reproach

v. 12

κρυφῆ

in secret

pertaining to not being able to be known by the public but known by some in-group or by those
 immediately involved, in secret, in private, secretly, privately

αἰσχρόν

pertaining to being socially or morally unacceptable, shameful, base
 pertaining to behaving in a disgraceful or shameful manner, disgraceful, shameful

v. 13

ἐλεγχόμενα PPPtcpNPN fr. ἐλέγχω

see above

φανεροῦται PPI3sg fr. φανερω
to cause to become visible, reveal, expose publicly, with relatively more focus on the sensory aspect than on the cognitive, pass. with the sense of show or reveal oneself, be revealed, appear

v. 14

φανερούμενον PPPtcpNSN fr. φανερω
see above

Ἐγειρε PAImp2sg fr. ἐγειρω
In a command to evoke movement from a fixed position, get up!, come!
to cause someone to awaken, to cause to wake up, to awaken someone, to wake up someone

καθεύδων PAPtcpMSV fr. καθευδω
to cease being awake, to sleep, to be spiritually indolent, be indifferent
the state of being asleep, to sleep, to be asleep, sleep

ἀνάστα AAImp2sg fr. ἀνίστημι
to come back to life from the dead, rise up, come back from the dead
to cause someone to live again after having once died, to raise to life, to make live again

ἐπιφάσει FAI3sg fr. ἐπιφασκω
to shine out on, arise, appear, shine upon someone
to cause light to shine upon some object, in the sense of illuminating it
