

Gal. 2:15-21

¹⁵. Even though we are Jews by nature, and not sinners from the Gentiles, ¹⁶. we know that a man is not justified by works of the Law, but he is justified only through faith in Jesus Christ. We believe in Christ Jesus, so that we will be justified by faith in Christ, and not by works of the Law, because everyone is NOT justified by works of the Law. ¹⁷. If while we are seeking to be justified in Christ, we also are found/proven to be sinners, is Christ therefore a servant of sin? Absolutely NOT! ¹⁸. If I rebuild the things which I destroyed, I demonstrate that I am a transgressor. ¹⁹. For I died to the Law through the Law, so that I may live to God. I have been crucified with Christ, ²⁰. I am no longer living Christ is living with reference to me. The life which I live in the flesh, I live by faith in the Son of God – the One Who loved me and gave Himself on behalf of me. ²¹. Therefore, I will not set aside the grace of God, because if righteousness could happen through the Law, then Christ died for not reason.
