

## Gal. 5:16-26

<sup>16</sup>. I am saying, walk/live by the Spirit, and you will certainly not carry out the desire of the flesh. <sup>17</sup>. For the flesh desires against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh. For these things oppose each other, so that you do not do whatever things you desire.

<sup>18</sup>. If you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the Law. <sup>19</sup>. The works of the flesh are plainly to be seen – sexual immorality, impurity, lack of moral restraint, <sup>20</sup>. idolatry, sorcery, enmity, rivalry, envy, rage, selfish ambition, discord, factions, <sup>21</sup>. jealousy, drunkenness, carousing, and things of a similar nature as these. I am telling you these things ahead of time, just as I said earlier, that those practicing these kinds of things will not inherit the Kingdom of God.

<sup>22</sup>. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, generosity, faith, <sup>23</sup>. meekness and self-control. There is no law against these kinds of things. <sup>24</sup>. Those of Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with the passions and desires.

<sup>25</sup>. If we live by the Spirit, we will live in conformity with the Spirit.

<sup>26</sup>. Therefore, let us not become conceited without reason, by provoking one another or by being envious of one another.
