

Gal. 6:1-10

¹. Brothers, if a man is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual, restore this one with a spirit of meekness, guarding yourself, so that you will not also be enticed. ². Carry the burdens of one another, and in this way, fulfill the law of Christ. ³. If someone believes themselves to be something, even though they are nothing, then they are deceiving themselves. ⁴. Let each one examine his own work. Then he will have his source of boast only in himself, and not in the other. ⁵. Because each one will carry his own load. ⁶. Let the one being taught the Word share in all good things with the one teaching. ⁷. Do not be deceived, God is not treated with contempt. Whatever a man plants, He will also harvest this. ⁸. The one planting into his own flesh harvests corruption from the flesh, but the one planting into the Spirit harvests eternal life from the Spirit. ⁹. When doing good, do not become discouraged. For we will harvest in its own time, if we do not become weary and give out. ¹⁰. Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us work the good toward all, especially toward the house of faith.
