



Jeremiah – 52 chapters

Title:

Jeremiah- Named after its Author, Jeremiah son of Hilkiah.

Author:

Jeremiah is the author of this book. Jeremiah was from a priestly family who lived within walking distance of Jerusalem. He probably wrote down part of the book after publicly preaching the same message. At least part of this book was probably written down by Baruch, Jeremiah's scribe, after it had been publicly spoken.

Occasion and Purpose:

Jeremiah speaks in the time of the Babylonian conquest of Judah. He speaks warning and lament of the impending tragedy. When the invasion comes, he counsels submission to Babylon as submission to God's righteous punishment (for which he was persecuted as a traitor). After the conquest, he speaks a message of hope, restoration, and new covenant.

Themes:

1. Sovereign God
2. Judgment for Idolatry
3. False Prophets
4. New Covenant Hope

Summary:

Jeremiah was a prophet who spoke before and during the time that God brought judgment on Judah for their sins. The main thrust of his message was that judgment was coming unless people repented and returned to God with their whole hearts. He is called the weeping prophet because he mourned over the coming judgment. Even in the midst of this horrible time, Jeremiah shines forth the great hope of the new covenant and faithfulness of God.
