to come to a realization, with implication of taking place less through instruction than through experience or practice, learn, appropriate to oneself  
to learn from experience, often with the implication of reflection, to come to realize  
to come to understand as the result of a process of learning, to understand

συκῆς

fig tree

θέρος

summer

κλάδος

tree branch

ἀπαλὸς

tender, i.e. early sprouts of trees in annual cycle, young shoots of a fig tree

φύλλα

leaf, foliage

ἐκφύη

PAS3sg

fr. εκφυω

give rise to something by a physical process, put forth, cause to grow, leaves sprouting  
begin vegetative growth, sprout

V. 33

οὕτως

referring to what precedes, in this manner, thus, so, pointing out the moral after figures of speech, parables, etc.

θύραις.

door, “he is near, at your very door”, cf. Jms. 5:9, Acts 5:9, Rev. 3:20

an idiom = soon, a point of time subsequent to another point of time and indicating imminence, the subsequent even is regarded as almost begun

to be no longer available for something, pass, to come to an end and so no longer be  
there, pass away, disappear  
to go out of existence, to cease to exist

## γενεὰ

sum total of those born at the same time, living at the same time, generation,  
contemporaries, Jesus looks upon the whole contemporary generation of Israel as a  
uniform mass, cf. 11:16; 12:41; 23:36 etc.  
possibly, those exhibiting common characteristics, race, kind cf. Lk 16:8  
possibly an indefinite period of time, cf. Acts 14:16

## ἕως

to denote the end of a period of time, till, until  
the continuous extent of time up to a point

παρελεύσεται                      FDI3sg                      fr. παρερχομαι  
παρέλθωσιν                      AAS3pl                      fr. παρερχομαι  
to be no longer available for something, pass, to come to an end and so no longer be  
there, pass away, disappear, in the sense of lose force, become invalid, cf. 5:18  
to go out of existence, to cease to exist
