

Matt. 28:16-20

- I. The disciples encountered Jesus in Galilee after the resurrection (16-17)
 - A. The eleven disciples went into Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus instructed them (16)
 - B. They encountered Him and hesitantly worshipped (17)
 - 1. They saw Him and worshipped (17a-b)
 - a And when they saw Him (17a)
 - b They worshipped (17b)
 - 2. But some doubted/hesitated (17c)
- II. Jesus' response to the disciples (18-20)
 - A. Jesus approached and spoke (18a-c)
 - 1. And after He approached (18a)
 - 2. Jesus spoke to them (18b-c)
 - a Jesus spoke to them (18b)
 - b Saying: (18c)
 - B. What He said – the Great Commission (18d-20)
 - 1. Because Christ has all authority, train all nations to live under His authority (18d-20a)
 - a All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me (18d)
 - b The inference from His Authority - command to make disciples (19-20a)
 - 1) The command to make disciples (19a-b)
 - a) Therefore, by going (19a)
 - b) Make disciples of all nations (19b)
 - 2) The means of making disciples (19c-20a)
 - a) Baptizing them into the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit (19c)
 - b) Teaching them to keep all of what I commanded you (20a)
 - 2. And behold, I am with you always until the completion of the age (20b)
