Ἰδὼν AAPtcpMSN fr. εἶδον

to perceive by sight of the eye, see, perceive
to see, sight

ὄχλους

a relatively large number of people gathered together, crowd
a casual non-membership group of people, fairly large in size and assembled for whatever purpose, crowd, multitude

ἀνέβη AAI3sg fr. ἀναβαίνω

to be in motion upward, go up, ascend, of movement in a direction without special focus on making an ascent
to move up, to come up, to go up, to ascend

ὄρος

a relatively high elevation of land that projects higher than a hill, mountain, mount, hill
a relatively high elevation of land, in contrast with hill, mountain

καθίσαντος AAPtcpMSG fr. καθίζω

to take a seated position, sit down
to be in a seated position or to take such a position, to sit, to sit down, to be seated, sitting, 'He went up on a hill, and sitting down...'

προσῆλθαν AAI3pl fr. προσερχομαι

to move towards, of physical movement come/go to, approach
to move toward a reference point, with a possible implication in certain contexts of a reciprocal relationship between the person approaching and the one who is approached, to move toward, to approach, to come near to

μαθηταὶ

one who is rather constantly associated with someone who has a pedagogical reputation or a particular set of views, disciple, adherent, especially of the disciples of Jesus
a person who is a disciple or follower of someone, disciple, follower

ἀνοιξας AAPtcpMSN fr. ἀνοίγω

to cause to function, open, of body parts, mouth, open the mouth, open one's own mouth to speak
idiom, literally, 'open the mouth,' to begin to speak in a somewhat formal and systematic manner, to address, to start speaking, to begin to speak, to utter

στόμα

mouth, of humans, as an organ of speech, open one's own mouth to speak
