

## Matt. 5:21-26

21. You have heard that it was said to the people of ancient times: Do not murder, and whoever would murder, this one will be liable to judgment. 22. And I am saying to you that everyone furious with his brother will be liable to judgment. Whoever would say to his brother “you fool,” this one will be liable to the Sanhedrin. But whoever would say “Moron,” this one will be liable to the hell of fire. 23. Therefore, if you would offer your gift on the altar, and there you remember that your brother has something against you, 24. leave your gift there before the altar. And go first to be reconciled to your brother, and then, coming [back], offer your gift. 25. Be making friends with your opponent quickly while you are with him on the road, in order that the opponent will not hand you over to the judge, and the judge to the bailiff, and you will be thrown into prison. 26. I am saying to you truly: you will certainly not go out from there until you will have paid back the last penny.
