

Matt. 6:19-24

19. Do not treasure up treasure for yourself on the earth, where moth and corrosion destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. 20. Rather, treasure up treasure for yourself in heaven, where neither moth nor corrosion destroy, and where thieves do not break in and neither do they steal. 21. For wherever your treasure is, your heart will also be there.

22. The lamp of the body is the eye. Therefore, if your eye is without guile, your whole body will be illuminated. 23. But if your eye is evil, your whole body will be darkened. Therefore, if the light in you is darkness, how severe the darkness must be?

24. No one is able to serve two masters, for he will either hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and he will despise the other. You are not able to serve God and worldly wealth.
