

Matt. 6:5-15

5. When you pray, do not be like the hypocrites. Because they love to pray while standing in the synagogues and on the corners of streets. I am saying to you truly, they have fully received their reward. 6. When you pray, go into your inner room and, locking the door, pray to your Father, Who is in Heaven. And your Father, Who is seeing in secret will reward you.

7. When praying, do not speak an abundance of unthoughtful, meaningless words, as the Gentiles. For they suppose that they will be listened to because of the length of their speech. 8. Therefore, do not be like them. For your Father knows a need which you have before you ask Him.

9. Therefore, you, pray in this way:

Our Father, the One in Heaven,

Let Your Name be revered as holy.

10. Let Your Kingdom come.

Let Your Will come to pass also upon Earth, as in Heaven.

11. Give us today our necessary food.

12. And forgive to us our guilt of sins, as we ourselves also have forgiven to those in debt of guilt to us.

13. Do not bring us into temptation.

But rescue us from evil.

14. For, if you forgive to people their transgressions, your Heavenly Father will also forgive to you. But if you do not forgive people, neither will your Father forgive your transgressions.
