מְזֹמֹר

technical term for psalm
melody, in 57 Psalm titles

לְתוֹדָה

thanksgiving, sacrifice of thanksgiving or a sacrifice of praise, also signifies associated songs, a title which can mean either a) a Psalm for a sacrifice of thanksgiving; or b) a Psalm for offering thanks, song of thanksgiving or song of praise
thanksgiving, thanksgiving in songs of liturgical worship, thanks offering

הִרְיעוּ

HiphImpMP
to rejoice, cheer, shout in triumph, with l to hail, to shout to, cf. Psa. 47:2, 66:1, 81:2, 95:1, 98:4, 6
shout with religious impulse, so in public worship and sacrifice, to God

QImpMP
to serve God in the cult, honor him, cf. Exo. 4:23, Deut. 6:13
serve God

בְּשִׂמְחָה

joy (its feeling as well as its display), jubilation, to sing praises with utmost joy
mirth, gladness, especially religious, cf. Psa. 4:8, 21:7 etc.

בְּרִנָּה

exultation, rejoicing, cf. Psa. 63:6, Job 3:7, 20:5
of joy, exultation

דָּעוּ

QImpMP
to know (by observation and reflection), cf. Exo. 6:7, 10:2, 14:4, 16:12, 29:46, Ezek. 6:7, 10, 13
know, learn to know

עֲשָׂנוּ

QPf3ms + 1cp

to create (of God), cf. Psa. 95:7

make, often of God's making (creating), making man, cf. Psa. 119:73

עַמּוֹ

people (with an emphasis on connections kinship and religious ceremonial) cf. Exo. 6:7, Deut. 4:20, 7:6, 14:2, Psa. 95:7

a people, nation

וְצֹאֵן

a collective, flocks (sheep and goats), metaphorical, may also denote persons under divine protection, care, and guidance, cf. Psa. 74:1, 79:13, 95:7

flocks, metaphorical of multitude, of Israel under Yahweh's care, cf. Psa. 74:1, 77:21, 78:52, 79:13, 80:2, 95:7

מִרְעֵיתוֹ

pasturage, cf. Psa. 74:1, 79:13, 95:7

pasturing, shepherding, pasturage, always figurative, of Israel as flock of Yahweh, cf. Jer. 23:1, Ezek. 34:31

V. 4

שַׁעֲרָיו

gates which do not have specific names, gates at the temple, its gates (the gates of the temple), as a gatehouse

gate of royal castle or palace, of temple, cf. Psa. 118:20

בְּתוֹדָה

see above

song of thanksgiving or song of praise

חֲצֵרֹתָיו

court, enclosure (around building), palace court, cf. Psa. 65:5, 84:3, 11, 92:14, 96:8, 135:2
enclosure, court, court of tabernacle, court(s) of Solomon's temple

בְּתֵּהֶלָּה

song of praise, cf. 22:25, 33:1, 71:6, 100:4, 109:1, 119:171, 147:1

the act of general, public, praise, 'enter his gates with thanksgiving, his courts with praise'

הודו

HiphImpMP

to praise God, cf. 6:5, 33:2, 75:1, 79:13, 92:1, 105:1, 136:2, 26

give thanks, laud, praise, of ritual worship, cf. 106:1, 107:1, 11:1, 118:29, 136:1

בִּרְכוּ

PielImpMP

to bless God = to declare God to be the source of the special power = to praise God

bless God, adore with bended knees, 'bless the name of Yahweh' cf. 96:2, 145:1, 21

V. 5

טוב

good (in all kinds of meanings), good as to character and value, morally good

pleasant, agreeable, good,

good, kind, benign, of God, Himself, 'for He is good, kind'

לְעוֹלָם

long time, duration (usually eternal, eternity, but not in a philosophical sense), cf. 106:1, 107:1, 118:1ff., 136:1ff.

long duration, antiquity, continuous existence, futurity, of divine existence, of Yahweh Himself, His attributes

חֶסֶד

in God's relationship with the people or an individual, faithfulness, goodness, graciousness, cf. 106:1, 107:1, 118:1ff., 136:1ff.

of God, kindness, lovingkindness in condescending to the needs of His creatures, specifically, lovingkindness in redemption from enemies and troubles, grouped with other divine attributes, kindness (lovingkindness) and fidelity, the kindness of God is everlasting

דָּר

lifetime, descent, generation, a period, 'generation after generation'

period, age, generation, usually of duration to come, future age(s)

אֱמוּנָתוֹ

trustworthiness, faithfulness, of God, cf. Psa. 33:4, 36:5, 40:10, 88:11, 89:1, 5, 8, 24, 33, 49, 92:2, 96:13, 98:3, 119:90, 138, 143:1

faithfulness, trust, as a divine attribute, it reaches unto all generations
