 - B. I will extol/thank the LORD with all my heart (1b)
 - C. in the assembly of the upright and in the congregation. (1c)
- II. [The works of the Lord] (2-4a)
 - A. Great are the works of the LORD; (2a)
 - B. Being inquired about by all who delight in them. (2b)
 - C. Splendor and majesty characterize His deeds, (3a)
 - D. And His righteousness stands forever. (3b)
 - E. He has made His wonders to be remembered; (4a)
- III. [The character of the Lord] (4b-5)
 - A. The LORD is gracious and compassionate, (4b)
 - B. He gives food to those who fear Him; (5a)
 - C. He will remember His covenant forever. (5b)
- IV. [The character of the works of the Lord] (6-9)
 - A. He has declared the power of His deeds to His people, (6a)
 - B. To give to them the inheritance of the nations. (6b)
 - C. The works of His hands are true/faithful and just; (7a)
 - D. all His precepts are true/confirmed/trustworthy. (7b)
 - E. They are supported for ever and ever, (8a)
 - F. [They are] done in truth/faithfulness and uprightness. (8b)
 - G. He sent redemption to His people; (9a)
 - H. He commanded His covenant forever- (9b)
 - I. Holy and awesome/fearful is His Name. (9c)
- V. [The fear of the Lord] (10a-b)
 - A. The fear of the LORD is the chief part/beginning of wisdom; (10a)
 - B. all who do them have prudence/insight. (10b)
- VI. His praise is established forever. (10c)
