

Rev. 5:1-14

- 1 Then I saw a scroll
in the right hand
of him
who was seated
on the throne
written
within
and on the back
sealed
with seven seals
- 2a And I saw a angel
mighty
b proclaiming
with a voice
loud
c "Who is worthy
d to open the scroll
e and break its seals?"
- 3a And no one was able
in heaven
or on earth
or under the earth
b to open the scroll
c or to look
into it
- 4a and I began to weep
loudly
b because no one
worthy was found
c to open the scroll
d or to look
into it

5a And one of the elders said to me
b "Weep no more
c behold
the Lion of the tribe of Judah
the Root of David,
d so that he can open the scroll and seals its seven."
6a And I saw
b between the throne and the creatures four living
and among the elders
a Lamb standing
c as though it had been slain
d with horns seven
and with eyes seven
e which are the spirits seven of God
f sent out into all the earth

7a And he went
b and took the scroll
from the right hand
of him
who was seated
on the throne

8a And when he had taken the scroll

b the living creatures
four fell down
and the elders before the Lamb
twenty-four

c each holding a harp
and bowls
golden
full of incense

d which are the prayers
of the saints

9a And they sang a song
new

b saying

c you are "Worthy

d to take the scroll

e and to open its seals

f for you were slain

g and you by your blood
ransomed people
for God from every tribe
and language
and people
and nation

10a and you have made them a kingdom
and priests
to our God

b and they shall reign
on the earth."

11a Then I looked

b and I heard the voice
of many angels
around the throne
and the living creatures
and the elders

c numbering myriads
of myriads
and thousands
of thousands

12a saying
with a voice
loud

b the Lamb who was slain is "Worthy

c to receive power
and wealth
and wisdom
and might
and honor
and glory
and blessing!"

13a And I heard creature
every
in heaven
and on earth
and under the earth
and in the sea
and all
that is
in them

b saying,

c "To him
who sits
on the throne
and to the Lamb
blessing
and honor
and glory
and might
be
forever and ever!"

14a And the living creatures said "Amen!"
four

b and the elders fell down

c and worshiped
