Rev 5:6 Then I saw a Lamb, looking as if it had been slain, standing in the center of the throne, encircled by the four living creatures and the elders.

Rev 5:7 He came and took the scroll from the right hand of him who sat on the throne.

Rev 5:11 Then I looked and heard the voice of many angels, numbering thousands upon thousands, and ten thousand times ten thousand. They encircled the throne and the living creatures and the elders.

Rev 5:13 Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, singing: "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!"

Eze 2:10 And he spread it before me. And it had writing on the front and on the back, and there were written on it words of lamentation and mourning and woe.

Rev 6:1 Now I watched when the Lamb opened one of the seven seals, and I heard one of the four living creatures say with a voice like thunder, "Come!"

Isa 29:11 And the vision of all this has become to you like the words of a book that is sealed. When men give it to one who can read, saying, "Read this," he says, "I cannot, for it is sealed."

Dan 8:26 The vision of the evenings and the mornings that has been told is true, but seal up the vision, for it refers to many days from now."

Dan 12:4-9 But you, Daniel, shut up the words and seal the book, until the time of the end. Many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall increase."

Rev 4:11 "You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being."

Rev 5:5 Then one of the elders said to me, "Do not weep! See, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has triumphed. He is able to open the scroll and its seven seals."

Rev 5:8 And when he **had taken the scroll**, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb,

Rev 5:9 And they sang a new song, saying, "Worthy are you **to take the scroll and to open its seals**, for you were slain,

ὁ ἐκ τῆς φυλῆς Ἰούδα

Gen 49:9-10 **You are a lion's cub, O Judah**; you return from the prey, my son. **Like a lion** he crouches and lies down, like a lioness who dares to rouse him? **The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until he comes to whom it belongs and the obedience of the nations is his.**

Heb 7:14 For it is clear that **our Lord descended from Judah**, and in regard to that tribe Moses said nothing about priests.

Rev 22:16 "I, Jesus, have sent my angel to give you this testimony for the churches. **I am the Root and the Offspring of David**, and the bright Morning Star."

Isa 11:1 A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; **from his roots a Branch will bear fruit.**

Isa 11:10 In that day the **Root of Jesse** will stand as a banner for the peoples; the nations will rally to him, and his place of rest will be glorious.

Jer 23:5 "The days are coming," declares the LORD, "when **I will raise up to David a righteous Branch, a King who will reign wisely and do what is just and right in the land.**

Jer 23:6 **In his days Judah** will be saved and Israel will live in safety. This is the name by which he will be called: The LORD Our Righteousness.

Rom 15:12 And again, Isaiah says, "**The Root of Jesse will spring up**, one who will arise to rule over the nations; the Gentiles will hope in him."

Rev 5:12 saying with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain,

Isa 53:7-8 He was oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; he was led **like a lamb to the slaughter**, and as a sheep before her shearers is silent, so he did not open his mouth. By oppression and judgment he was taken away. And who can speak of his descendants? For he was cut off from the land of the living; for the transgression of my people he was stricken.

Joh 1:29 The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, **the Lamb of God**, who takes away the sin of the world!

1Pe 1:19-20 but with the precious blood of Christ, **a lamb without blemish or defect**. He was chosen before the creation of the world, but was revealed in these last times for your sake.

Rev 5:9 And they sang a new song, saying, "Worthy are you to take the scroll and to open its seals, **for you were slain**, and by your blood you ransomed people for God

Rev 5:12 saying with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb **who was slain**, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!"

Rev 13:8 All inhabitants of the earth will worship the beast--all whose names have not been written in the book of life belonging to **the Lamb that was slain** from the creation of the world.

Rev 12:3 And another sign appeared in heaven: behold, a great red dragon, with seven heads and **ten horns**, and on his heads seven diadems.

Rev 13:1 And I saw a beast rising out of the sea, with **ten horns** and seven heads, with ten diadems on its horns and blasphemous names on its heads.

Rev 13:11 Then I saw another beast rising out of the earth. It had **two horns** like a lamb and it spoke like a dragon.

Rev 17:3 And he carried me away in the Spirit into a wilderness, and I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast that was full of blasphemous names, and it had seven heads and **ten horns**.

Rev 17:7 But the angel said to me, "Why do you marvel? I will tell you the mystery of the woman, and of the beast with seven heads and **ten horns** that carries her.

Rev 17:12 And **the ten horns** that you saw are ten kings who have not yet received royal power, but they are to receive authority as kings for one hour, together with the beast.

Rev 17:16 And **the ten horns** that you saw, they and the beast will hate the prostitute. They will make her desolate and naked, and devour her flesh and burn her up with fire,

1Sa 2:10 those who oppose the LORD will be shattered. He will thunder against them from heaven; the LORD will judge the ends of the earth. "He will give strength to his king and exalt **the horn of his anointed**."

Luk 1:69 He has raised up **a horn of salvation** for us in the house of his servant David

Psa 132:17 "Here I will make **a horn** grow for David and set up a lamp for my anointed one.

Eze 29:21 "On that day I will **make a horn** grow for the house of Israel, and I will open your mouth among them. Then they will know that I am the LORD."

τὰ ἑπτὰ πνεύματα τοῦ θεοῦ

Rev 1:4 John, To the seven churches in the province of Asia: Grace and peace to you from him who is, and who was, and who is to come, and from **the seven spirits before his throne**,

Rev 3:1 "To the angel of the church in Sardis write: These are the words of him who holds **the seven spirits of God** and the seven stars. I know your deeds; you have a reputation of being alive, but you are dead.

Rev 4:5 From the throne came flashes of lightning, rumblings and peals of thunder. Before the throne, seven lamps were blazing. **These are the seven spirits of God.**

Zec 4:10 "Who despises the day of small things? Men will rejoice when they see the plumb line in the hand of Zerubbabel. "(**These seven are the eyes of the LORD**, which range throughout the earth.)"

2Ch 16:9 For the **eyes of the LORD range throughout the earth** to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to him. You have done a foolish thing, and from now on you will be at war."

Zec 4:10 "Who despises the day of small things? Men will rejoice when they see the plumb line in the hand of Zerubbabel. "(These seven are **the eyes of the LORD, which range throughout the earth.**)"

V. 7

Rev 5:14 The four living creatures said, "Amen," and **the elders fell down** and worshiped.

Rev 4:10 **the twenty-four elders fall down before him** who sits on the throne, and worship him who lives for ever and ever. They lay their crowns before the throne and say:

Rev 19:4 **The twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down** and worshiped God, who was seated on the throne. And they cried: "Amen, Hallelujah!"

Rev 8:3-4 Another angel, who had a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense to offer, with **the prayers of all the saints**, on the golden altar before the throne. The smoke of the incense, together with the prayers of the saints, went up before God from the angel's hand.

Psa 141:2 May **my prayer be set before you like incense**; may the lifting up of my hands be like the evening sacrifice.

V. 9

ᾄδουσιν ᾠδὴν καινὴν

Rev 14:3 And **they sang a new song** before the throne and before the four living creatures and the elders. No one could learn the song except the 144000 who had been redeemed from the earth.

Psa 33:3 **Sing to him a new song**; play skillfully, and shout for joy.

Psa 40:3 He put **a new song** in my mouth, a hymn of praise to our God. Many will see and fear and put their trust in the LORD.

Psa 96:1 Sing to the LORD a new song; sing to the LORD, all the earth.

Psa 98:1 A psalm. Sing to the LORD a new song, for he has done marvelous things; his right hand and his holy arm have worked salvation for him.

Psa 144:9 I will sing a new song to you, O God; on the ten-stringed lyre I will make music to you,

Psa 149:1 Praise the LORD. Sing to the LORD a new song, his praise in the assembly of the saints.

Isa 42:10 Sing to the LORD a new song, his praise from the ends of the earth, you who go down to the sea, and all that is in it, you islands, and all who live in them.

Rev 14:4 These are those who did not defile themselves with women, for they kept themselves pure. They follow the Lamb wherever he goes. They were purchased from among men and offered as firstfruits to God and the Lamb.

Mat 20:28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

Act 20:28 Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood.

1Co 6:20 you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body.

1Co 7:23 You were bought at a price; do not become slaves of men.

Eph 1:7 In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace

Col 1:14 in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Titus 2:14 who gave himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify for himself a people that are his very own, eager to do what is good.

1Pe 1:18-19 For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your forefathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect.

Rev 7:9 After this I looked and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and in front of the Lamb. They were wearing white robes and were holding palm branches in their hands.

Rev 11:9 For three and a half days men from every people, tribe, language and nation will gaze on their bodies and refuse them burial.

Rev 14:6 Then I saw another angel flying in midair, and he had the eternal gospel to proclaim to those who live on the earth to every nation, tribe, language and people.

V. 10

βασιλείαν καὶ ἱερεῖς

Rev 1:6 and has made us to be a kingdom and priests to serve his God and Father to him be glory and power for ever and ever! Amen.

Rev 20:6 Blessed and holy are those who have part in the first resurrection. The second death has no power over them, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with him for a thousand years.

Rev 22:5 There will be no more night. They will not need the light of a lamp or the light of the sun, for the Lord God will give them light. And they will reign for ever and ever.

Exo 19:6 you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. These are the words you are to speak to the Israelites."

1Pet 2:5 you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

1Pet 2:9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession,

Dan 7:27 Then the sovereignty, power and greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven will be handed over to the saints, the people of the Most High. His kingdom will be an everlasting kingdom, and all rulers will worship and obey him.

Rev 19:6 Then I heard what sounded like a great multitude, like the roar of rushing waters and like loud peals of thunder, shouting: "Hallelujah! For our Lord God Almighty reigns.

Deu 33:2 He said: "The LORD came from Sinai and dawned over them from Seir; he shone forth from Mount Paran. He came with myriads of holy ones from the south, from his mountain slopes.

Psa 68:17 The chariots of God are tens of thousands and thousands of thousands; the Lord has come from Sinai into his sanctuary.

Dan 7:10 A river of fire was flowing, coming out from before him. Thousands upon thousands attended him; ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him. The court was seated, and the books were opened.
