

Rom. 8:9-11

- I. If you have the Spirit, you are changed into Christ's status and life (9-10)
 - A. Those with the Spirit are changed, those without are not Christ's (9)
 - 1. Those with the Spirit living in them are not in flesh, but in spirit (9a-c)
 - a You are not in flesh, but in spirit (9a-b)
 - 1) Neg: You [pl.] are not in flesh (9a)
 - 2) Pos: But [you are] in spirit (9b)
 - b Assuming the Spirit of God is living in you (9c)
 - 2. Someone without the Spirit is not Christ's (9d-e)
 - a And if someone does not have the Spirit of Christ (9d)
 - b This one is not of Him (9e)
 - B. If Christ is in you, the share Christ's death and His life (10)
 - 1. If Christ is in you (10a)
 - 2. The body is dead, but the spirit is life (10b-c)
 - a Neg: The body is dead because of sin (10b)
 - b Pos: The spirit is life because of righteousness (10c)
- II. If you have the Spirit, He will give you Christ's resurrection life (11)
 - A. And if the Spirit, Who raised Jesus from the dead, is living in you (11a)
 - B. The One Who raised Christ from the dead will give life to your mortal body through His Spirit Who is dwelling in You (11b)
